Cyflwyniad

Mae'r canllaw hwn yn rhoi crynodeb o'r grantiau sydd ar gael o dan y cynllun grantiau Coetiroedd Gwell i Gymru (CGG). Mae CGG yn cael ei weinyddu gan Comisiwn Coedwigaeth Cymru (CCC). Mae rhai o'r grantiau a geir dan y gynllun CGG yn cel eu hariannu'n rhannol gan y Gynllun Datblygu Gweledig ar gyfer Cymru 2007-2013, dan Echelin 2. Ariennir hyn gan Lywodraeth Cynulliad Cymru a'r Undeb Ewropeaidd.

Mae'r cynllun Coetiroedd Gwell i Gymru wedi'i ddatblygu ar gyfer coetiroedd Cymru a dim ond yng Nghymru y mae ar gael.

Mae grantiau ar gael ar gyfer creu a gwella coetiroedd a chânt eu disgrifio yn y categorïau canlynol:

- **Plannu Newydd** - creu coetiroedd newydd
- **Ailstocio** - ailblannu ar ôl clirdorri neu dorri detholus
- **Rheoli Coetiroedd** - rheoli a gwella gwerth amgylcheddol a chymdeithasol coetir drwy reoli coed feithrin yn gadarn

Mae'r tablau dros y dudalen yn grynodeb o'r grantiau sydd ar gael. Telir y grantiau ar ôl cwblhau gweithrediadau a nodir mewn cynllun rheoli wedi'i gymeradwyo. I gael mwy o wybodaeth dylai ymgeiswyr ddarllen 'Coetiroedd Gwell i Gymru - Canllaw i Berchenogion Coetiroedd'. Mae mwy o gyngor ar y cynllun Coetiroedd Gwell i Gymru yn cael ei ddarparu gan gynllunwyr rheoli sydd wedi'u cymeradwyo, asesu, a'u hyfforddi gan CCC i baratoi cynlluniau.

Introduction

This guide provides a summary of the grants available under the Better Woodlands for Wales (BWW) grant scheme administered by the Forestry Commission Wales (FCW). Some of the grants delivered under BWW are part funded by the Rural Development Plan for Wales 2007-2013, under Axis 2. This is financed by the Welsh Assembly Government and the European Union.

BWW has been developed for Welsh woodlands and is only available in Wales.

Grants are available for creating and improving woodlands and are described in the following categories:

- **New Planting** - creating new woodlands
- **Restocking** - replanting after clear felling or selective felling
- **Woodland Management** - managing and improving the environmental and social value of woodland through sound silvicultural management

The tables over-page are a summary of the grants available. The grants are payable on completion of operations set out in an approved management plan. For more information applicants should read 'Better Woodlands for Wales - A Guide for Woodland Owners'. More advice on BWW is provided by management planners who have been assessed, approved and trained by FCW to prepare plans.

Fencing costs are grant aidable separately from the planting grant at a rate of £1.75/metre.

DEFINITIONS:

- Local, native planting stock - plants derived from locally collected seed - see Forest Practice Guide 8.
- Core Networks/Focal Networks - these are areas identified by FCW and the Countryside Council for Wales (CCW), as having good potential to form linked habitat networks.

Improved Land Premium Rates

For new woodlands planted on more productive agricultural land, an annual payment is available for 10 years to compensate for loss of income.

In order to qualify as a farmer, at least 25% of your income must be derived from agriculture.

An additional £150/ha is payable for planting local native planting stock.

Replanting grant is not applicable for restocking by natural regeneration. Instead Woodland Improvement Grant is available for work to secure natural regeneration and to manage it subsequently.

Grantiau Rheoli Coetir

Mae grantiau ar gael ar ffurf Grantiau Gwella Coetir (WIG) ar gyfer amrywiaeth eang o weithredoedd i wella coetiroedd. Mae'r tablau dilynol yn dangos y cyfraniad grant tuag at gost 'safonol' gwneud y gwaith. Rhaid i gostiadau gael eu paratoi fel rhan o'r cynllun rheoli gan ddefnyddio cyfrifydd grant gwella coetir.

Gwaith Coed Feithrin a Gwaith Amgylcheddol

Mae'r gyfradd grant ar gyfer rhai gweithredoedd yn amrywio o 25-75% yn ôl cyd-destun y gwaith sy'n cael ei wneud.

Hefyd, mae amrywiaeth eang o waith coed feithrin a gwaith amgylcheddol arall yn gymwys ar gyfer WIG ar 50%. Mae hyn yn cynnwys rheoli gwiwerod, isadeiledd i rheoli ceirw, gwaith ôl-sefydlu (glanhau ac ail-fylchu, gwaredu cysgodfeydd coed) yn ogystal â rheoli glannau afonydd, gwaith i wella a diogelu rhywogaethau pwysig y Cynllun Gweithredu Bioamrywiaeth, gwaith tirlun, a gwaith i ddiogelu safleoedd archaeolegol. Gellir cael cymorth grant ar gyfer costau ffensiô stoc ar 50%, £1.75/metr yw hwn ar hyn o bryd.

Woodland Management Grants

Woodland Improvement Grants (WIG) are available for a wide range of operations to improve woodlands. The tables that follow show the grant contribution towards the 'standard' cost of doing the work. Costings must be prepared as part of the management plan using FCW's grant calculator.

Silvicultural and Environmental work

The grant rate for some operations varies from 25-75% according to the context in which the work is being carried out.

A wide range of other silvicultural and environmental work is also eligible for WIG at 50%. This includes squirrel control, infrastructure for deer management, post establishment work (cleaning, respacing and removing tree shelters), as well as riparian management, work to enhance and protect important Biodiversity Action Plan species, landscape work, and work to protect archaeological sites. Stock fencing is grant aided at 50%, currently this is £1.75/metre.

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Gwaith i Wella Coetiroedd i Bobl

Mae Grantiau Gwella Coetir ar gael ar gyfer gwella mynediad, darparu addysg a cyfleusterau hamdden ar hyd at 75% o'r gost, gan ddiybnu ar y math o waith a'r cyd-destun. Nid yw'r grantiau hyn ar gael mewn coetiroedd nad oes ganddynt fynediad i'r cyhoedd.

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Work to Improve Woodlands for People

Woodland Improvement Grants are available for improving access and providing education and recreation facilities at up to 75% of cost, dependent on the type of work and the context. These grants are not available in woodlands without public access.

Grants cannot be used to meet the cost of legal obligations e.g. in respect of Public Rights of Way.

Management Plan Preparation Grants - Payment Rates

Forestry Commission Wales provides grant-aid so that applicants can engage an approved management planner to prepare a management plan on their behalf. The plan includes the grant application.

Fee	Rate	Description
Plan	£500	A fixed rate paid on all plans regardless of size
Area	Area under 25ha at £33/ha Area over 25ha at £6.75/ha	A per hectare rate paid on the area of a plan
Polygon	£14	A set rate paid for each separate woodland block within a Plan
Briefing	£100	A set rate paid each time a management planner has to process a specialist assessment

In addition, there are also grants for specialist assessments which may be needed in certain situations. Management planners can give advice about the cost of preparing plans and the grants available for plan preparation.
