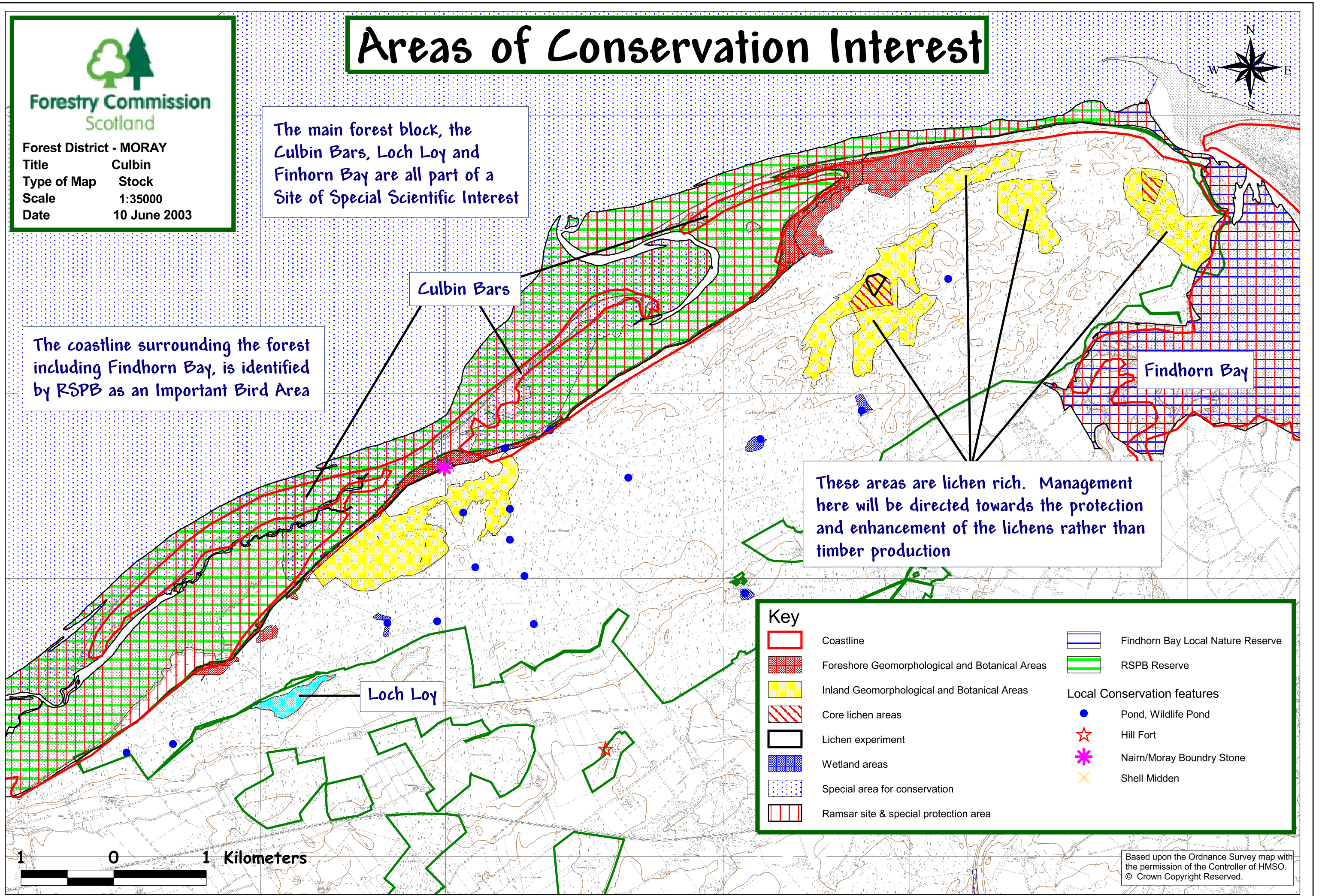

Areas of Conservation Interest

The main forest block, the Culbin Bars, Loch Loy and Findhorn Bay are all part of a Site of Special Scientific Interest

The coastline surrounding the forest including Findhorn Bay, is identified by RSPB as an Important Bird Area

These areas are lichen rich. Management here will be directed towards the protection and enhancement of the lichens rather than timber production
