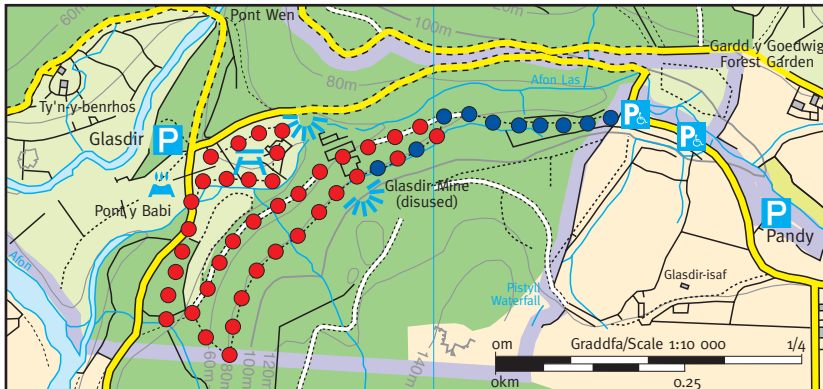

Glasdir Copper Trail - The route



O'r maes parcio, croeswch y ffordd i weirglodd a safle picnic Ty'n-y-buarth, a dilynwch y llwybr coch i lawr at Afon Babi lle, yn ôl traddodiad lleol, y cipiodd y tylwyth teg faban ffarmwr lleol a gadael un o'u babanod eu hunain yn ei le.

Croeswch Afon Babi dros y bont ffordd isaf ac yna ewch mewn cylch o gwmpas yr hen waith Copr nes cyrraedd yr wylfan ar y lefel uchaf lle gallwch weld y safle cyfan a'r dyffryn islaw.

Gallwch gerdded yn eich blaen a dod at yr Ardd Goed o'r cyfeiriad hwn – dilynwch yr arwyddion gwyrdd o'r lefel uchaf.

Mae'r llwybr copr yn cynnwys nifer o risiau, wrth fynd i fyny ac wrth ddod i lawr drwy'r hen waith.

Gall pobl abl ac anabl fynd at yr wylfan o'r maes parcio i'r anabl ger y bont uchaf dros Afon Babi.

Rhowch gynnig ar y peiriant weindio er mwyn clywed am fywyd yn y gwaith Copr lle'r oedd 160 o bobl yn gweithio ar un adeg. Mae'r llwybr yn addas ar gyfer yr abl a'r anabl ac mae ar raddiant hawdd (10% / 1 mewn 10 ar y mwyaf), ac mae'n addas ar gyfer cadeiriau olwyn.



From the car park cross the road into Ty'n y Buarth meadow and picnic site and follow the red trail down to the Afon Babi, where local folklore says a fairy baby was exchanged for a local farmers child.



Cross the Afon Babi at it's lower road bridge and then take a circular tour of the old copper workings rising to the upper tier where a viewpoint offers a vista over the whole site and river valley below.

You can extend the walk to reach the Forest Garden from here – pick up the green waymarkers from the upper level.

The copper trail has a number of flights of steps both on the steep ascent and descent through the old workings.

All ability access to the viewpoint is available from the disabled only car park next to the upper bridge across the Babi.

Try the wind-up sound store to hear about life in the Copper works where 160 people once worked. The trail is built to all ability standards with an easy gradient (max 10%/1 in 10) and is suitable for wheelchair users.
