The ballad's called the Baron of Braichlie, Braichlie is to the left hand side coming out of Ballater just on yer way up to – Glen Muick is muic which is Glen of the Pigs in Gaelic - so it would be Gleann Muick in the old traditional Gaelic. Baron of Braichlie came down because he was a Farquharson and they were the traditional enemies of the Gordons. Braichlie was owned by a Gordon laird and this was the song, the traditional song.
