●●●	<b>Wild Wood Trail</b> 2 km / 1.25 mile. Allow an hour	
●●●	<b>Working Wood Trail</b> 2.5 km / 1.5 miles. Allow an hour	
●●●	<b>Colony Trail</b> 4 km / 2.5 miles. Allow two hours	
●●●	<b>Mither Tap Timeline Trail</b> 4.5 km / 3 miles. Allow two and a half hours	
●●●	<b>Mither Tap Maiden Causeway</b> 5.5 km / 3.5 miles. Allow two and a half hours	
●●●	<b>Millstone Hill Trail</b> 5.5 km / 3.5 miles. Allow two and a half hours	
—T—	<b>Turnpike Trail</b> 6.5 km / 4 miles. Allow two hours	
●●●	<b>Mither Tap Quarry Trail</b> 9 km / 5.5 miles. Allow three and a half hours	
●●●	<b>Mither Tap Heather Brig Trail</b> 10 km / 6 miles. Allow four hours
