Much of Cudworth Common is elevated above the surrounding area so views over the RSPB Edderthorpre Ings reserves, can be enjoyed as you wander around the site. Keep an eye open for the wooden sculptures which celebrate the site's mining heritage and its new future as a community woodland. Ferrymoor Flash, although separated from the main part of the site, should not be missed when visiting because a fantastic range of wildlife inhabits this small wetland area.

LOCATION

Between the towns of Cudworth and Grimethorpe off the A6195 (Engine Lane) near Sash Windows. Access can also be gained via the public right of way from the Pinfold car park, Cudworth.
