

# DINNINGTON

## COMMUNITY WOODLAND

Dinnington is fast gaining a reputation for its birdlife, over 50 species have been seen in a single day. There is a bird hide overlooking the wetland area so you can see what interesting birds are visiting the site. Close to the local community this woodland and wetland area is full of newly planted trees and wildflowers. The woodland is fantastic for an evening walk or an afternoon out with the family for fun and picnics.

### LOCATION

Turn onto A57 Sheffield Road, signposted for Worksop. At Todwick crossroads turn left onto B6463, Dinnington Road, which becomes Todwick Road. Turn right onto Church lane. Follow for approximately a quarter of a mile. The site gate is just before the housing estate on the right hand side of the road.
