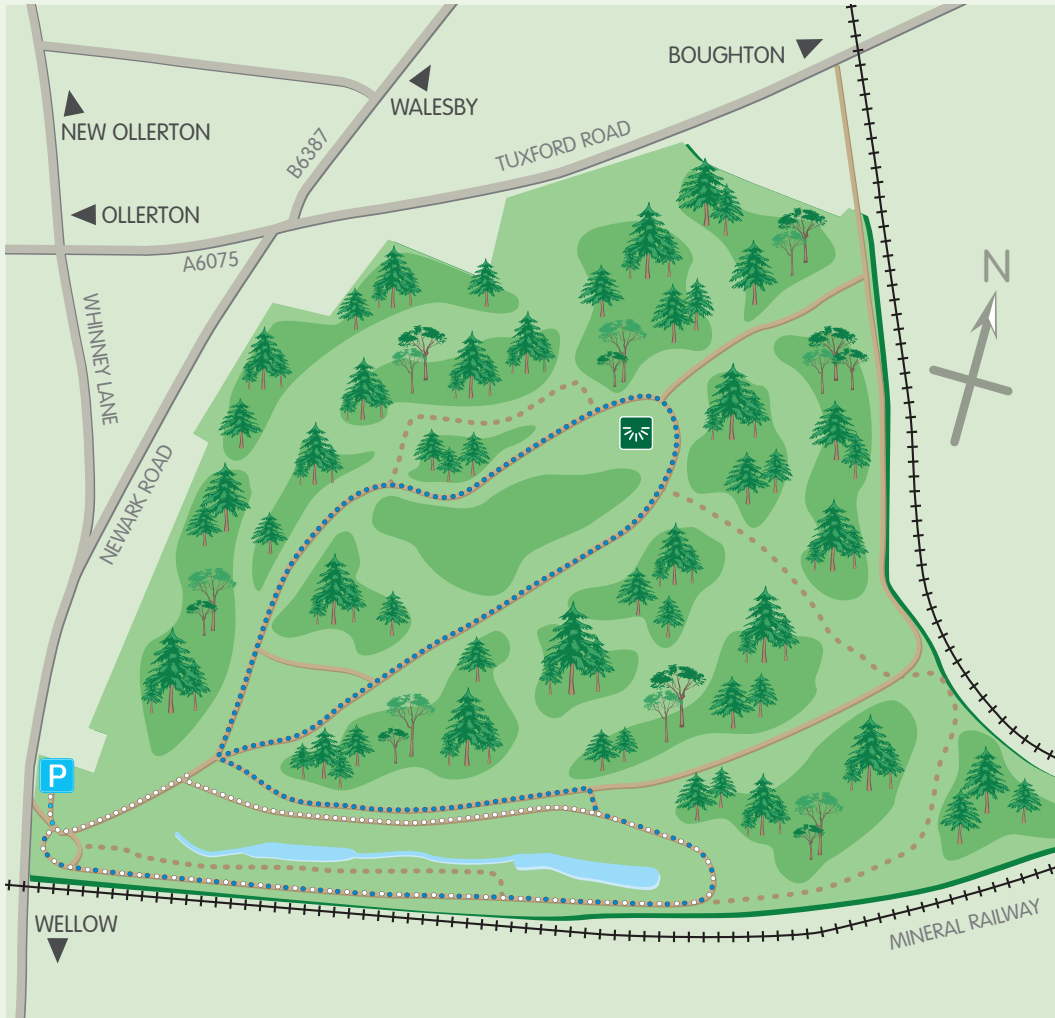


Explore Ollerton Pit Woods



From woodland to wetland Ollerton Pit Woods has something for everyone. Once a former colliery site the area now boasts a wild strawberry walk, nesting swans and a whole host of wildlife.

Enjoy spectacular views of the surrounding area and depending on the time of year you visit you may even see a flock of Hebridean sheep that are helping to create an area of heathland.

Surfaced tracks and way-marked trails create circular routes from the car park. The White Trail round the pond is suitable for all. For the more adventurous try hiking to the pit top for great views of the surrounding countryside including Clumber Park, Thoresby Colliery and Wellow Wood.

Directions: From the A614 take the A616 and A6075 into Ollerton. Turn right onto Whinney Lane, then onto Newark Road. The car park is on your left. NG22 9UH. SK667673.
