

Explore Oxclose Wood

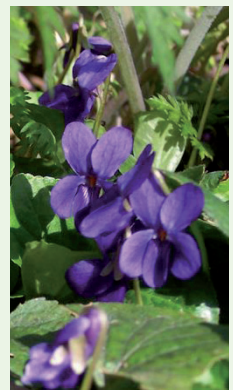
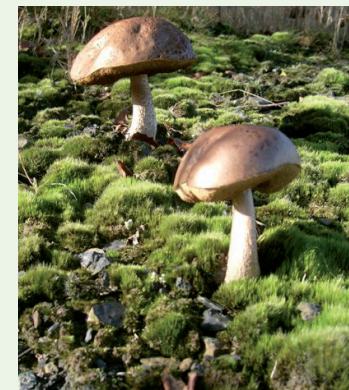


On the outskirts of Mansfield Woodhouse, Oxclose Wood is an oasis of tranquillity in a busy urban setting. Enjoy the mixture of woodland, wetland and grassland as you walk around the wood.

Banks of orchids, the song of the skylark and the hovering kestrel are all here to be discovered.

Surfaced trails make it a lovely place to walk, reflect, be creative and simply enjoy the beauty around you. Steep climbs are rewarded by spectacular views of the surrounding area.
