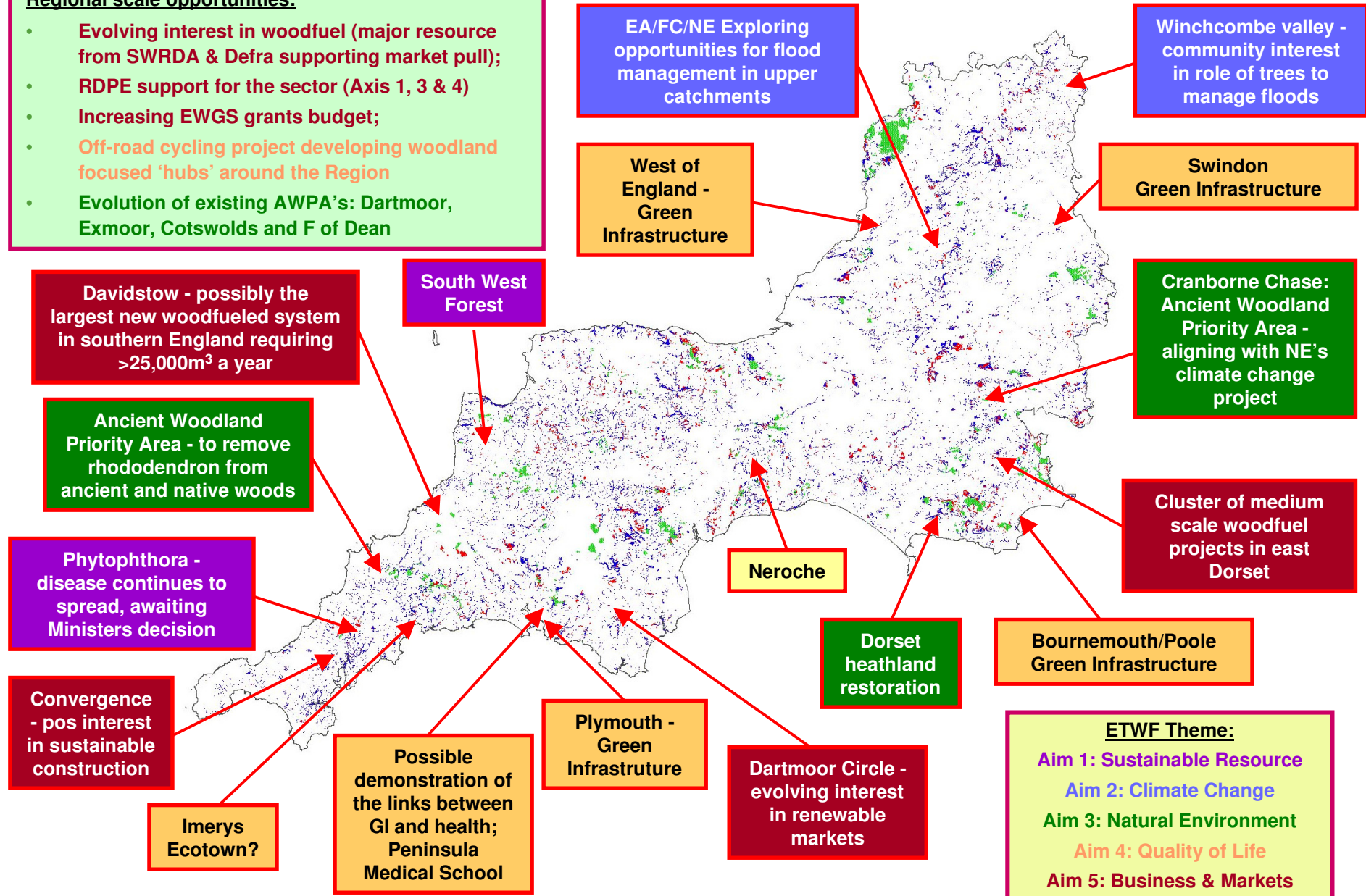


Evolving projects in the south west

212,000 ha of existing woodland

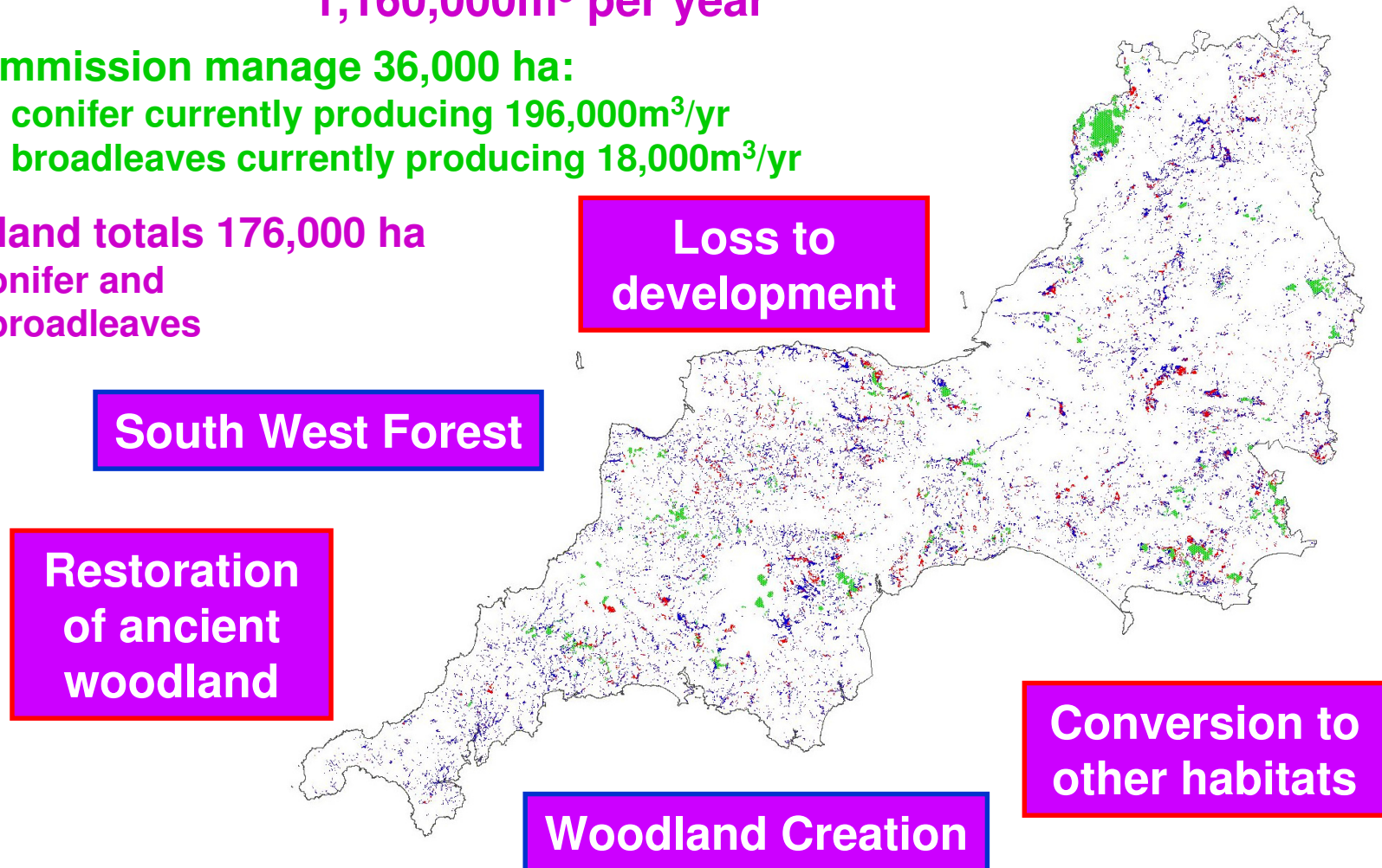
An estimated potential sustainable growth of
1,160,000m³ per year

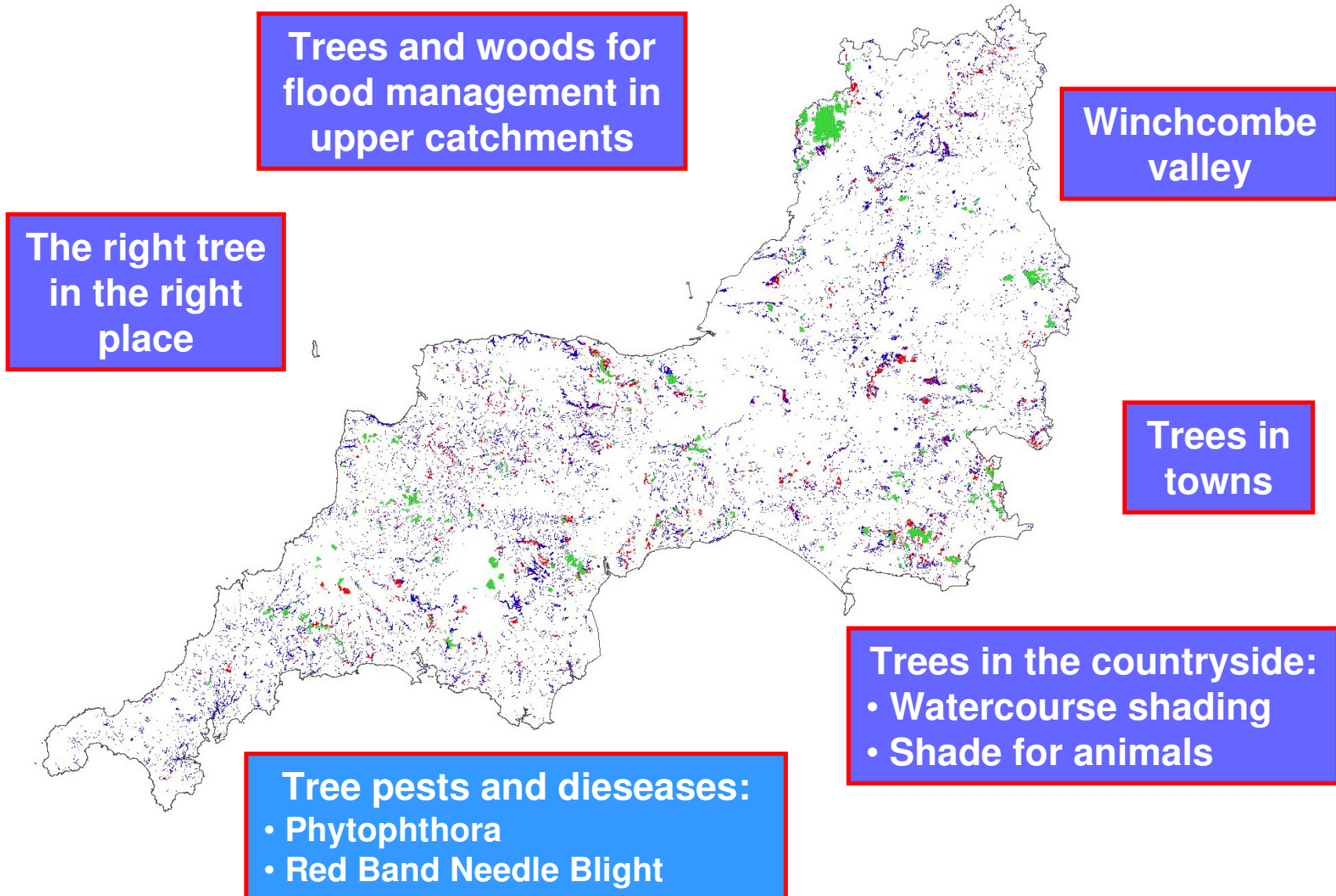
Forestry Commission manage 36,000 ha:

- 21,000 ha of conifer currently producing 196,000m³/yr
- 15,000 ha of broadleaves currently producing 18,000m³/yr

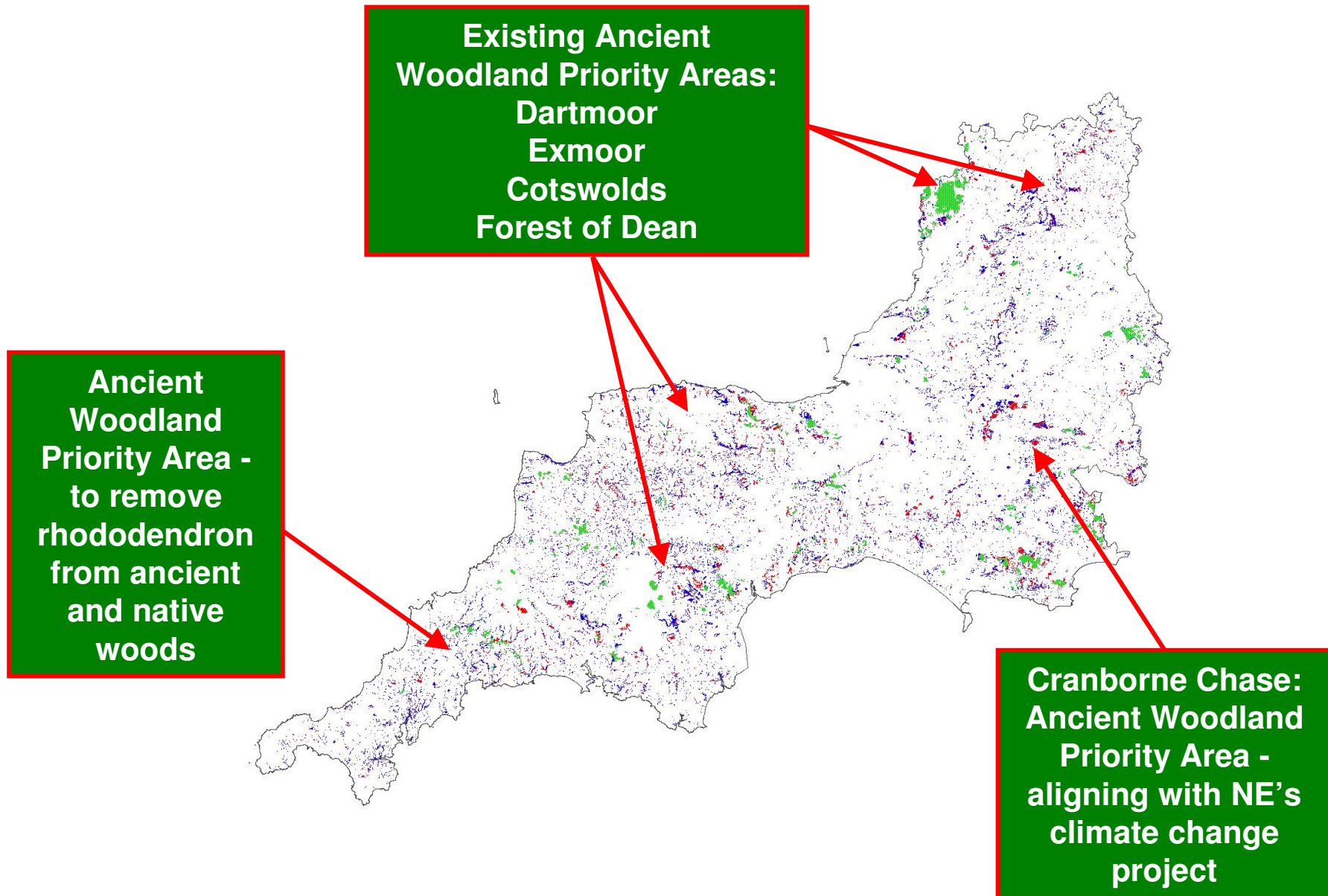
Other woodland totals 176,000 ha

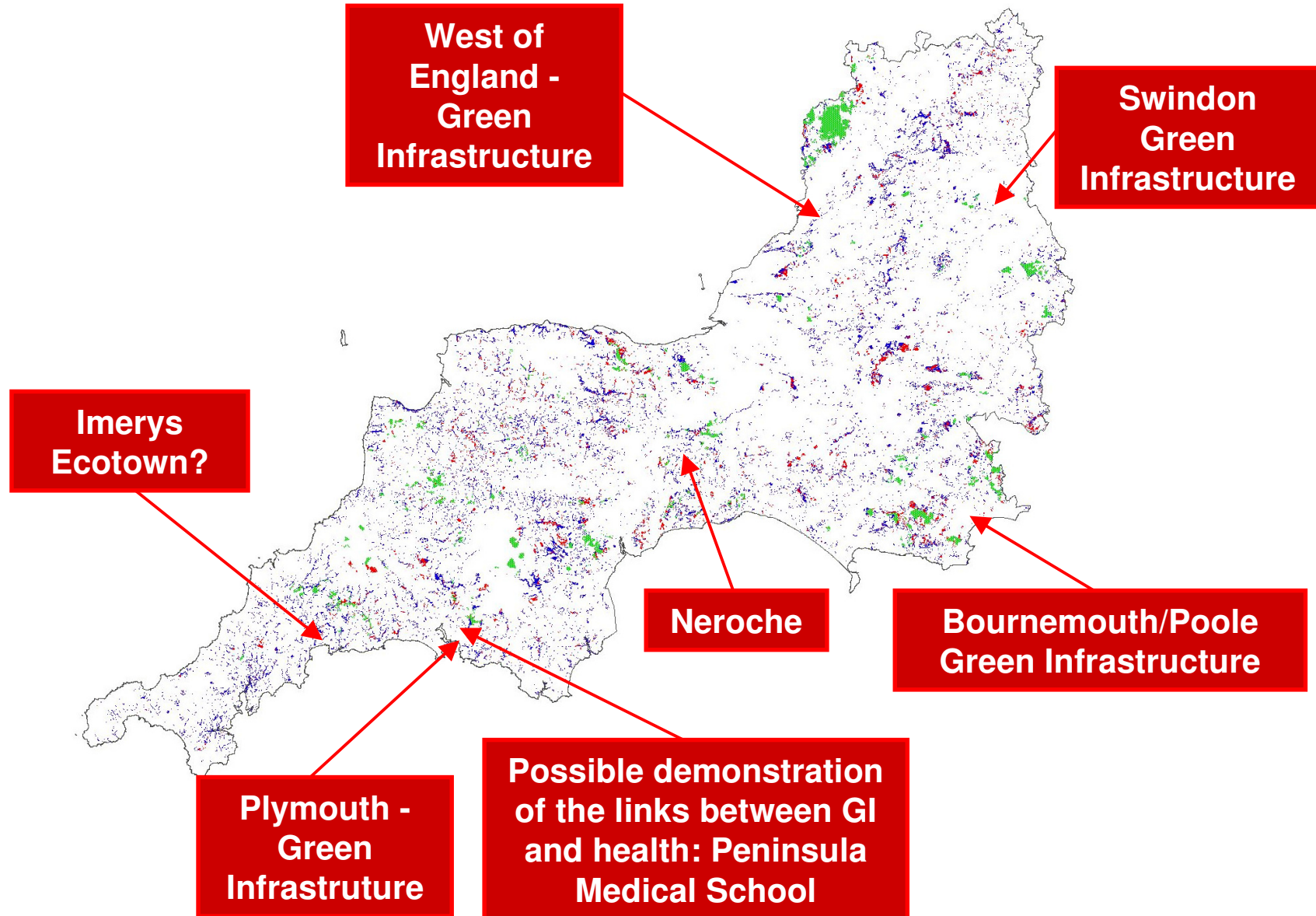
- 39,000 ha conifer and
- 137,000 ha broadleaves



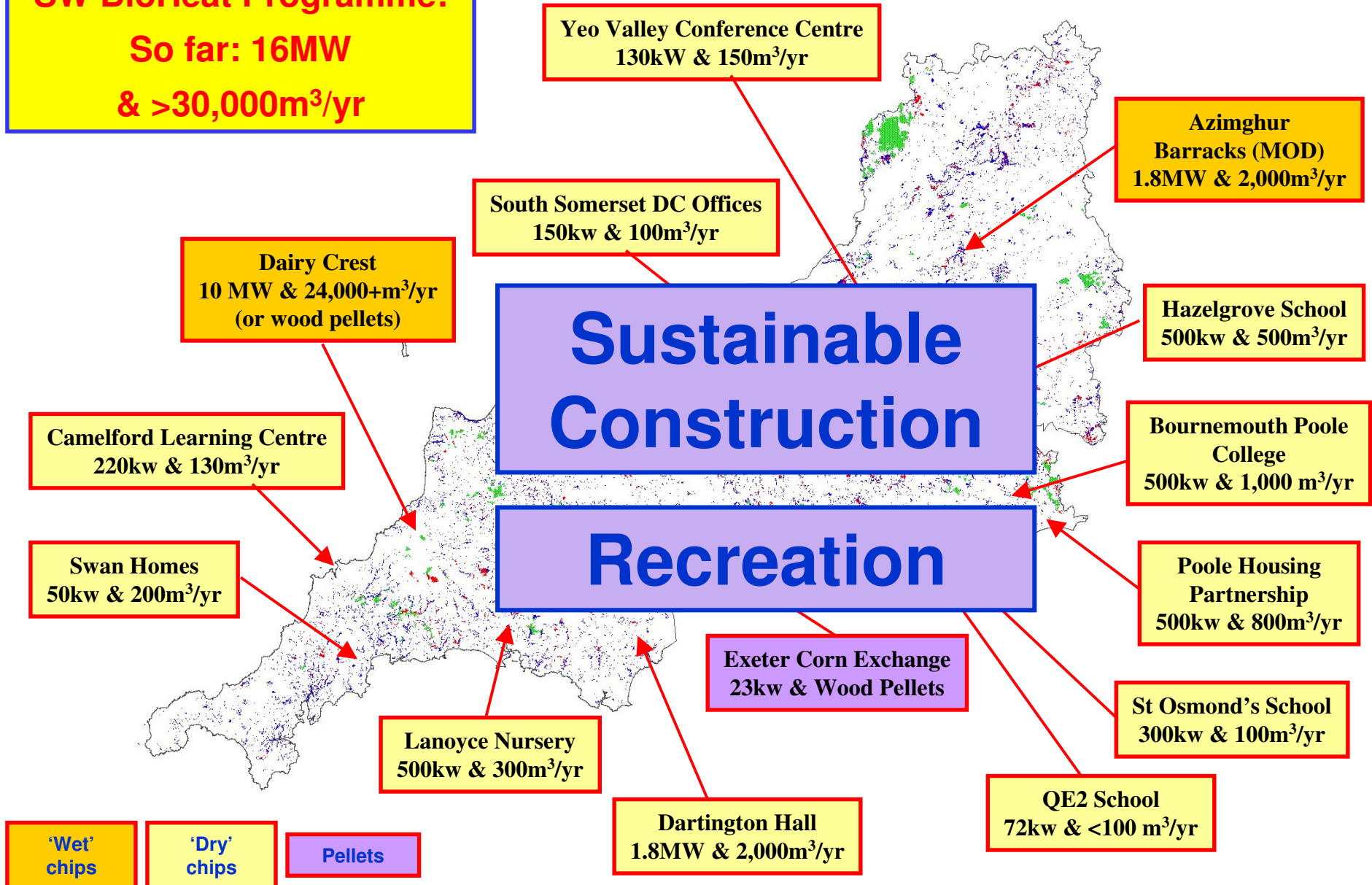
