Help keep the New Forest a special place ...

- ▶ Always keep your dog in sight and under control.
- ▶ Never let your dog disturb or chase wildlife or livestock.
- ▶ Keep your dog to main tracks on the Open Forest when birds nest (1 March to 31st July). Respect requests to do this; it will help protect important wildlife.
- ▶ Remove poo on paths, and where people play or picnic. Bag it and bin it in any litter bin, or take it home.
- ▶ Be considerate of other forest users, especially children and picnickers.
- ▶ Check regularly for ticks, and watch out for adders in open areas, which could harm your pet.
- ▶ Ensure your dog wears a collar with your name and address (a legal requirement). A mobile number is useful too.
- ▶ Worm your dog regularly and keep vaccinations up to date.
