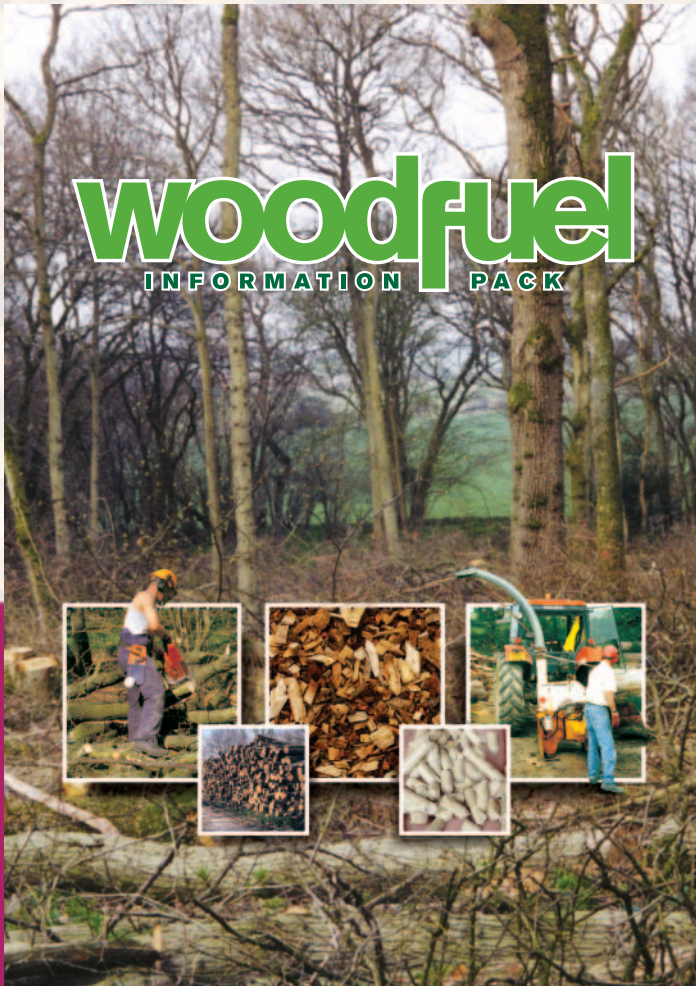

# Woodfuel is news again, attracting fresh attention as a clean and sustainable source of renewable energy.

The **Woodfuel Information Pack** brings together key, basic information about the many aspects of using wood for fuel. These include background on benefits, renewable energy targets and policy; sources; conversion; end users and systems.

The pack is the result of several years' development work by Forest Research and clearly outlines the benefits of using wood as fuel.

Ten individual topics are provided, grouped into four sections and ring-bound in a tough polypropylene cover. This allows for new information to be inserted, and additional topics are already in preparation.
