

## Directions



Bicton Arena is 9 miles from Junction 30 of the M5. Take the turning to Sidmouth. After ½ mile, turn towards Exmouth at the roundabout. After 1 mile on the dual carriageway, turn left to Woodbury and Yettington on the B3179. Continue for 5 miles and Bicton Arena is on the left immediately after the village.
