Community Coppice Practical Conservation Activities

(season dependant)

November – March

Help us restore our derelict native coppice wood, much of which has been un-worked since the 1930's. Tasks include felling of small trees, burning deadwood and brash and selecting wood for products (bean poles, hazel hurdles, faggots etc).

April – May

Learn the traditional skills needed to restock our coppice coups by layering and stooling hazel trees.

June – October

Help us manage some of our 17 miles of paths by undertaking essential ride widening using hand tools to clear brambles, dead wood and invasive species.

Other estate management activities may also be available.
