CONDITIONS

1. This Permission is personal to you and is not transferable.
2. The Permission may be revoked at any time at the discretion of the Forestry Commission by notice given to you in writing. (In the event of revocation being made to meet the Commission's requirements a refund of the sum paid will be made pro-rata for the unexpired period of the Licence and permission. In the event that the revocation is required as a result of the default of you or members of your organisation then no refund will be made of any part of the sum paid).
3. The lands over which this permission is granted are vested in the DEFRA hereinafter called the Forestry Minister and neither he nor the Forestry Commission shall be liable to you for any injury or damage howsoever caused which you, your horses/ponies or members of your organisation, may suffer in the exercise of the rights granted.
4. You and the members of your organisation will take care to avoid any injury or damage to persons or property in the exercise of this permission. You will be held responsible for your own actions/the acts of the members of your organisation and others under your control while on the Commission's property and will pay full compensation for any damage or injury suffered by the Forestry Minister, the Forestry Commission his or their tenants, employees, contractors and others and shall indemnify the Forestry Minister and the Commission and his or their tenants, employees, contractors or others against any claim made against him or them in respect thereof
5. You will take out an Insurance Policy for an amount of not less than £5 million pounds which sum shall not be taken as limiting your liability in respect of any one claim to cover any injury or damage caused by your own actions/the acts of the members of your organisations and others under your control and when requested forward for inspection the policy and receipt for the last premium. (This requirement is not necessary where riders are full members of the British Horse Society, affiliated Clubs and the British Show Jumping Association and proof of membership is produced).
6. Without prejudice to the foregoing generalities you and those under your control will specifically be bound:-
 - a. Not to light any fires on or near the Commission's property
 - b. To refrain from smoking while on the Commission's property
 - c. To leave all gates across routes in the position in which they were found
 - d. Not to take any dogs on the area
 - e. To take all reasonable care not to disturb any game birds or their nests or eggs
 - f. To avoid breaking up the surface of routes by galloping or cantering
 - g. Not to erect jumps
7. Damage by horse or pony passage to road, especially if they are wet or soft can be lessened if the centre of the road is avoided. Please be considerate to other users of the forest.
8. If arriving by horsebox please park at the unboxing area marked on the map. You are advised to ensure that your vehicle is left secure and does not obstruct gateways. Please leave the area clean on departure
9. Other events occur throughout the year so please observe any notices.
10. Shooting may take place in the Forest from time to time. When signs are erected stating shooting is in progress, you must not proceed beyond these signs.
