

New Forest Safe Barbecue Code

- Static Barbecue hearths are available for hire at Anderwood and Wilverley. If you are planning a barbecue for over 20 people then please book one of these sites. For more information please call us on 0300 067 4601.
- Disposable BBQ's are welcome in the forest at the following sites: Bolderwood, Blackwater and Wilverley where stands and water are available for safe usage.
- The forest is a special place and we ask that you help to keep it that way by ensuring all rubbish, including BBQ coals, are taken away with you. Please ensure water is available to extinguish your BBQ. No collection of wood from the forest is allowed. BBQ's which are in breach of the code or not considered safe will be extinguished. In extreme weather conditions check the website for guidance on using BBQs in the New Forest.
- Raised non-disposable BBQs are permitted on the hard standing of the Forestry Commissions car parks providing that water is available and they are fully extinguished after use.
- Make sure you have enough water to ensure your BBQ can be extinguished fully after use, and BBQ waste to be taken home.
