What? Mountain bike trail checking and maintenance training course

We regularly check our mountain bike trails at here Whinlatter to identify areas that need some work and to make sure they are safe. If you bike here you'll know that it's important to keep the trails in shape so that riders can get the most out of them. It would be great if the Friends of Whinlatter could help out with this. Come along and join a training day with our ranger and then get involved in the work parties that follow to tidy up the trails and carry out maintenance.....

When?

Saturday 14th May 9am-1pm

OR

Wednesday 1st June 9am- 1pm

Where? meet outside Ranger's Office (next to Visitor Centre) at Whinlatter

What to bring sturdy outdoor footwear, waterproof clothing, a drink and snack. During the session, you will walk the North section of the trail, so will need to cover about 10km and be comfortable walking up and down hills on relatively steep ground. You will also be using tools provided by the Forestry Commission during the session.

Where? meet outside Ranger's Office (next to Visitor Centre) at Whinlatter

What to bring sturdy outdoor footwear, waterproof clothing and a packed lunch. During the session, you will walk up and down hills on relatively steep ground and may cover several kilometres by walking. You will also be using tools provided by the Forestry Commission during the session.
