January

Saturday 22nd - Owl Adventure - 11am (1 hour) - £20 per person - Minimum of 8years old

Working with Cheshire Falconry guests accompany an expert falconer as he exercises his owls in the forest. Chat about Britain's birds of prey and come face to face with largest species of owls in the world.

Sunday 23rd - Hawk Walk - 11am (1 hour) - £20 per person - Minimum of 8years old

Guests accompany an expert falconer from Cheshire Falconry around the forest on a walk with their hawk. Learn all about the hawk, its natural history and that of the UK's birds of prey. You will have the chance to handle and fly the hawk.

February

Tuesday 22nd - Bird Feeders - £2 per child - 10.30 - 11.30am or 1.30 - 2.30pm

A fun and messy event making bird feeders to take home and feed our birds ready for rearing their chicks.

October

Wednesday 26th - Bat Walk (for children) -£4 per person - 6.30 - 8pm

Our education ranger will take you on a walk around the forest discovering the bats using detectors. Ideal for younger children.

Friday 28th - Pumpkin Carving -£4.50 per person - 10.30am - 12pm or 1.30 - 3pm

Our extremely popular Halloween event. Each child will receive a pumpkin to carve and take home ready to light up their path on Halloween. Other crafts and activities are also available.
