Abstract: The term urban heat island (UHI) describes a phenomenon where cities are on average warmer than the surrounding rural area. Empirical data is required on the role of greenspaces in mitigating the UHI. We describe a five-month study to measure the variability in air temperature across one large greenspace in London. Results demonstrate cooling of up to 6 degrees C in the immediate vicinity of Kensington Gardens. Cooling was ranged from 20 to 300m from the park. Results support claims that urban greenspace is an important component of UHI mitigation strategies.
