Abstract: In this report, we discuss the findings of the GREEN SURGE Work Package 6 Tier 1 research on identifying and conceptualising innovative participatory governance arrangements in regards to the management of urban green infrastructure. At the basis of this research is the policy arrangement approach, which implies that, although governance arrangements are driven by agents, they operate within a structural context. Four main research questions are addressed: 1) Which trends affect the governance of urban green spaces? 2) How do governments deal with questions surrounding participation in their green space policies and related practices? 3) Who are involved with green space policies and who initiates what projects? And 4) what are the intended outcomes of initiatives?
