Get a crayon and do a bark rubbing of your favourite tree!



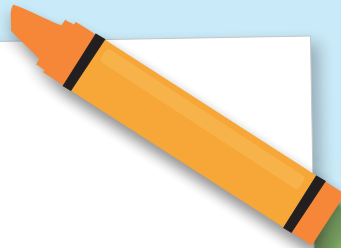
