Location

The Drumossie Hotel is situated in the heart of the highlands, 3 miles South East of Inverness City Centre. It is 20 minutes travel time by taxi from Inverness Airport, and approximately 10 minutes from Inverness Train Station.

By Road - Approaching from South
Exit from the A9, after the Tourist Information Centre, at the junction for Milton of Leys. Follow road round to round-about. Take the 2nd exit off the round-about and follow road which takes you back under the A9. Take the 1st exit off the round-about and follow road down hill. Drumossie Hotel is on the left.

By Road - Approaching from North
Follow signs for the A9 to Perth. Exit the A9 at the junction for Milton of Leys. Follow road round to round-about. Take 2nd exit off the round-about and follow road down hill. Drumossie Hotel is on the left.

By Rail
10 mins from Inverness Railway Station. Edinburgh = 2.5 hrs; Glasgow = 3 hrs; Aberdeen = 2 hrs.

15 mins drive from Inverness Airport.
