

The Forestry Commission has now considered the application and the information provided by the applicants in an Environmental Statement and has decided to give consent for the proposals subject to the following conditions:

- The deforested parts of the site to be managed as a mosaic of upland heath, blanket bog and semi-natural grassland; and
- The remaining conifer woodland to be retained and converted to native woodland over a period of 10 to 30 years in order to minimise the impact of the proposals on important woodland fauna.
