ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (FORESTRY) (ENGLAND AND WALES)  
REGULATIONS 1999**

**BLACKBROOK PLANTATION RESTORATION PROJECT**

The preparation of an Environmental Statement in connection with an application for consent under the Environmental Impact Assessment (Forestry) (England and Wales) Regulations 1999 to carry out deforestation, was advertised in this newspaper on 15 April 2011 in accordance with the Regulations.

The application for consent was made by the Staffordshire Wildlife Trust to the Forestry Commission for a project to restore 14 hectares of conifer woodland located near Leek on the Staffordshire Moorlands of the Peak District National Park to a mosaic of upland heath, blanket bog and semi-natural grassland to be managed for nature conservation.

The Forestry Commission has now considered the application and the information provided by the applicants in an Environmental Statement and has decided to give consent for the proposals subject to the following conditions:

- The deforested parts of the site to be managed as a mosaic of upland heath, blanket bog and semi-natural grassland; and
- The remaining conifer woodland to be either retained or converted to native woodland over a period of 10 to 30 years in order to minimise the impact of the proposals on important woodland fauna.
