### **Grampian Regional Forestry Forum Chair**

**Forestry Commission Scotland is looking for a chair of the Grampian Regional Forestry Forum. Appointment is for a 3 year period, with the option to re-appoint. The chair role is expected to take around 8-10 days per year and as such will receive payment of £2307; the position is also eligible for applicable expenses.**

The Forum advises Forestry Commission Scotland on implementing the Scottish Forestry Strategy within the Grampian Conservancy. The Forum covers the local authority areas of Moray, Aberdeenshire and Aberdeen City.

You'll be an effective leader of Forum meetings, a strategic thinker, and enjoy working with others. You'll preferably have previous experience of chairing forums or groups and have particular knowledge and experience in at least one of the following: forest management, integration of forestry with agriculture, environment, rural development, commercial forestry or timber processing.

The Forum meets 3 times a year and may set up smaller working groups to take forward specific issues.
