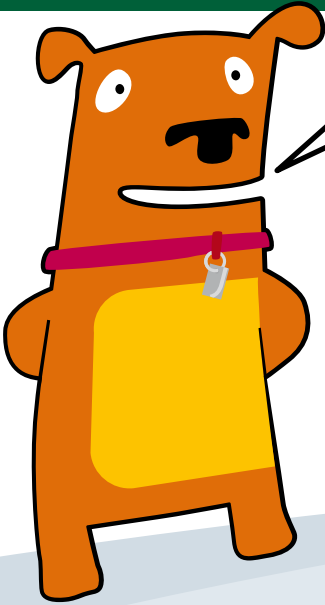


Visiting Jeskyns with your dog

Control your dog

Always ensure your dog is in sight and comes back when called.



Protect farm animals and wildlife

Never let your dog approach or chase farm animals or wildlife.

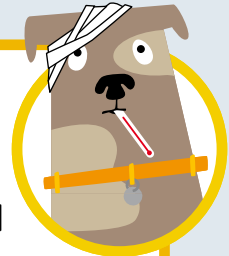


Know where you can go

In some areas, dogs are not allowed or must be kept on a lead.

Keep your dog safe and healthy

Regularly worm and vaccinate him and ensure he wears a collar with your contact details.



Consider others

Never let your pet approach other people, dogs or horses uninvited.



Clean up

Always bag and bin your dog's waste.



Room for everyone

Jeskyns is not just a place for dogs!



Jeskyns is a great place and considerate owners with well behaved dogs are always welcome.

However, please remember that many visitors without dogs come to enjoy the space and peace and quiet.

Therefore please keep your dog under close control at all times and do not enter the dog free areas.

Dogs allowed on a lead here



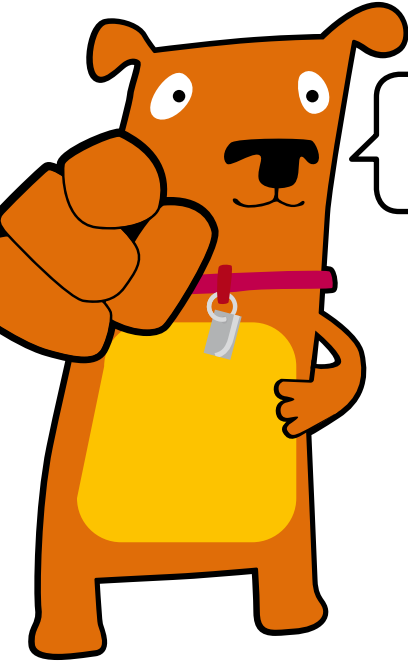

Jeskyns is also a popular place with horse riders. Horses, like dogs can be unpredictable, so to stay safe:

- Always look out for horses, their special trails are marked on the map.
- If you see a horse approaching, promptly get your dog at your side and clip on the lead.
- Stand to one side so that horses can pass with their hooves well away from your dog.
- Make eye contact and smile, so riders can see that you are being safe and considerate.

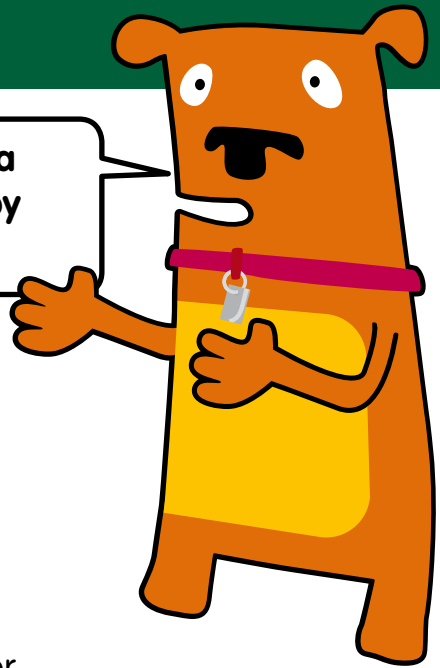
