Remember the three C's

Help us ensure Jeskyns is a great place for everyone by observing the 3 C's

1 Clean up
Always bag and bin your dogs waste.

2 Control
Ensure you have close control of your dog at all times.

3 Consideration
Please do not allow your dog to approach other visitors uninvited.



Know your zones
In some areas dogs are not allowed or must be kept on a lead.



Consider others
Don't let him approach people, other dogs or horses uninvited.



Clean up
Always bag it and bin it.



Control
Ensure you have close control of your dog at all times.



Protect farm animals and wildlife
It is a criminal offence to allow your dog to worry wildlife or livestock.



Keep your dog safe and healthy
Regularly worm and vaccinate him and ensure he wears a collar with your contact details.

Map key

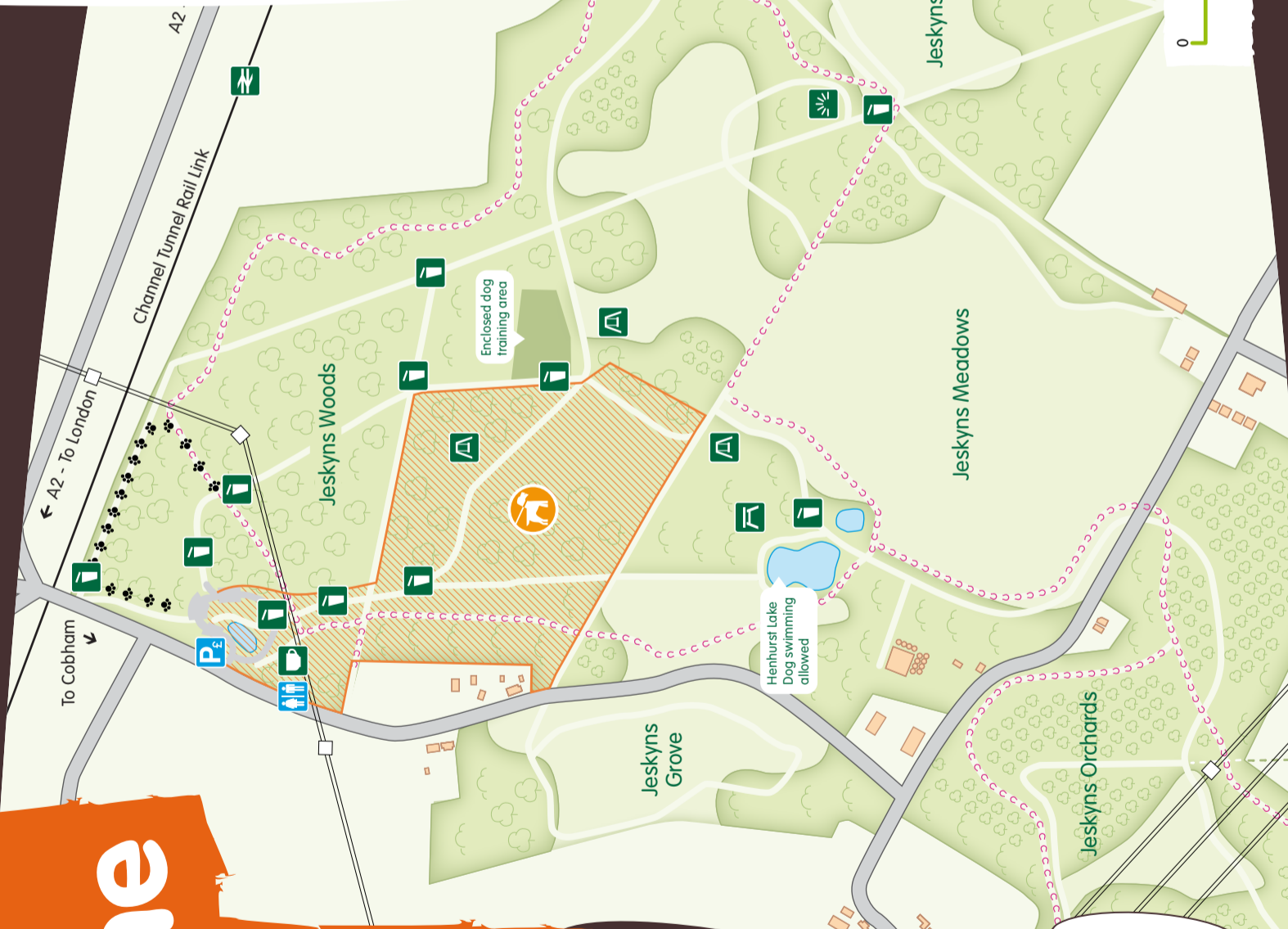

Jeskyns is also a popular place with horse riders. Horses, like dogs can be unpredictable, so to stay safe...

- 1** Always look out for horses, their special trails are marked on the map.
- 2** If you see a horse approaching, promptly get your dog at your side and clip on the lead.
- 3** Stand to one side so that horses can pass with their hooves well away from your dog.
- 4** Make eye contact and smile, so riders can see that you are being safe and considerate.

Follow the Forest Code

-  Guard against all risks of fire.
-  Protect and respect wildlife, plants and trees.
-  Keep dogs under control & tidy after them.
-  Take your litter home.
-  Make no unnecessary noise.
-  Take only memories away.

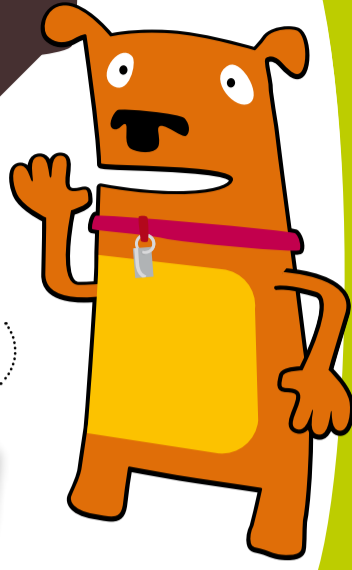
