

Integrated Environmental and Economic Accounting for Forestry: UK 2012 data

Introduction

The Integrated Environmental and Economic Accounting for Forestry (IEEAF) collects economic data on forestry. Statistics are collected annually by Eurostat.

The attached table shows data for 2004-2012. Estimates for 2012 are shown for the first time in this return. Estimates for 2011 and earlier years have been subject to revision since the release of 2011 data in October 2013, to reflect revisions to underlying data.
