Booking the Colliers View barbecue area at Beechenhurst Lodge

The Forest of Dean is cared for by:

£25 for sites 1 or 2

Payment by cheque/card in advance

What's included:

- » One metal barbecue hearth (bring your own charcoal), from 10.30am until site closing time.
- » Two picnic tables for your exclusive use.
- » Two free allocated parking spaces.

Don't forget...

- » The barbecue and barrier gate must be locked upon your departure.
- » Please leave the site and barbecue clean and tidy.
- » There is a recycling point close to the lodge for your litter.
- » Disposable bbqs can be deposited in the metal BBQ bin, please dampen these first with water at the tap.
- » Please park a maximum of two vehicles in the allocated bay. All other vehicles must purchase a pay and display ticket and park in the main car park.
- » Sorry no amplified music, licensed bars, or fires. Forestry Commission Byelaws 1982 (revised 1994).
- » The Forestry Commission will not accept liability for any damage, loss or injury to persons, vehicles etc, however caused.
- » For commercial or fundraising events, permission is required from the Forestry Commission. Allow eight weeks for your application to be processed.
