Frequently asked questions



Where can we get involved?

Team building and corporate challenges are run in woodlands across North Nottinghamshire, Derbyshire, South Yorkshire and Lincolnshire. Some of our programmes may only be available at selected sites. Please get in touch to find out where your nearest opportunities are.

Toilets are only available at a couple of our woodlands, although there are plenty of private places to go! Portalooos can be arranged if needed but would incur an additional cost.

What does the day include?

Your day will be tailored to the needs and interests of your group. No previous experience is necessary. All rangers are trained/qualified to run the activities. Your ranger on the day will clearly explain and demonstrate all of the tasks you are to get involved in. All equipment, tools, materials and personal protective equipment is provided.

Light refreshments of tea, coffee and biscuits are also provided, although you may have to boil the water in a storm kettle!

What do we need to bring?

Participants will need to dress for the weather and have sturdy footwear. Please be aware you are outdoors so you could get muddy. The British weather is unpredictable so you may want to bring sun protection or waterproof clothing depending on the season. It doesn't hurt to be prepared. For practical conservation days outdoor footwear with good ankle support is necessary.

Lunch is not provided but packed lunches could be arranged at an extra cost.

What will it cost?

A ranger-led teambuilding day or corporate challenge tailored to the needs and interests of your group will cost:-

< 10 people	=	£250
11 - 15 people	=	£300
16 - 20 people	=	£350
21 - 25 people	=	£400
25 +	please contact us	for further details.

Overnight Bushcraft Adventures are available from £40 per head.

N.B. Some programmes have a maximum number of participants.



Where does our money go?
