In September and October some of the larger trees in Risbeth Wood will be felled to allow more light into the woodland and encourage young trees to grow up below the mature ones.

Modern harvesting machinery is dangerous (for example the chain which cuts through the tree can travel 200m if it breaks!) and the driver cannot necessarily see someone approaching. For your own safety please obey the "no entry" signs around the site (coloured yellow on the map).

Whilst work is going on the red walk trail will be closed and the red mountain bike trail will be closed for part of the time. Please see the website for up to date information or ask at the High Lodge Visitor Centre shop.

We apologise for the inconvenience this will cause but hope that you can continue to enjoy the wood once work is complete.
