

Daffodils

You will need

- Yellow and green crepe paper
- Willow stick
- Masking tape
- Scissors

What to do

1. Cut out 6 yellow petals so that the grain runs across the petal.
2. Cut out a yellow rectangle about 8cm long and stretch one of the long edges to frill it.
3. Roll it into a tube around the top of the willow stick and tape in place.
4. Arrange the 6 petals around the daffodil trumpet and tape in place.
5. Now take a long strip of green crepe paper and wind around the stick, covering up the masking tape first before spiralling it down the stick.
6. Tie the strip off at the bottom.
