

APPENDIX 8 - THREESTONEBURN FOREST ARCHAEOLOGICAL SURVEY

LIST OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES WITHIN FOREST BOUNDARY

(See attached map for locations)

1. Stone Circle N 1756 – Scheduled Monument

Remains of Bronze Age stone circle situated near the burn to west of Threestoneburn House. Site is in area of existing open space and comprises 16 pink granite stones, four of which are standing.

2. Cairn field N 1771 – Scheduled Monument

Remains of Bronze age cairn field situated to North of Threestoneburn House. At least 12 cairns identifiable in area of existing open space.

3. Hut circle N 1722 – Scheduled Monument

Prehistoric hut circle on south bank of burn, to west of Threestoneburn House. Evidence of smaller hut circle lie to side. Both sites in existing open space area.

4. Stone circle N 1308

Possible site of prehistoric stone circle situated on summit of Dunmoor Hill in South-east corner of property.

5. Flint & Pottery N 1786

Fragments of Neolithic or early bronze age flint and pottery found to south of Threestoneburn house when area was cultivated.

6. Cairn field N 1312

Remains of cairn field that has been damaged by cultivation prior to tree planting. This area is within tree planting area.

7. Cairn N 1773

Single bronze age cairn, located on edge of forest.
