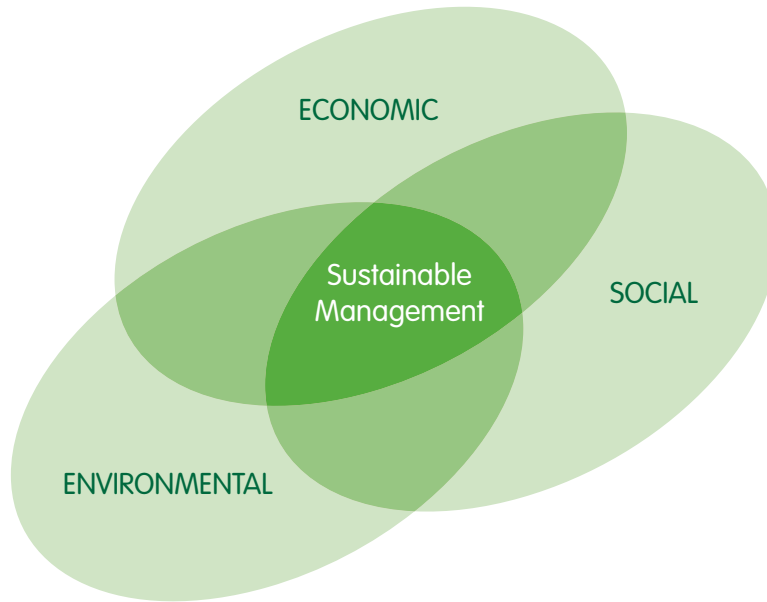


4. The shared vision

Each forest district will remain responsible for managing their own woodland and it is every district's overarching objective to adopt a strategy that aims to secure a balance between the three drivers of sustainable forest management:



The three districts' objectives are summarised by the following vision:



This vision will be realised through these three drivers of the Forest Enterprise East of England Regional Strategic Plan:

- **Social:** Contribute to the quality of life for a wide range of people
- **Environmental:** Maintain and enhance the bio-diversity, cultural value and landscape character of our estate
- **Economic:** Management of the estate to benefit the wider economy

These objectives will be delivered in accordance with the following principles:

- **Sustainable Management:** To be an exemplar of sustainable land management.
- **Forestry Commission Values:** Create a positive and pleasant working environment through adherence to these values.
- **Partnership working:** To deliver public benefit by working with others.

These drivers and the action framework represent the shared vision of the three districts. They encompass all of the districts' objectives and the principles by which each district intends operating. These drivers and principles inform all of the districts' action plans.
