

Autumn Leaf Jar

Autumn is here and the leaves are falling! Why not collect some of that wonderful colour and take it home with you! Use the leaves and reuse a jam jar to make an autumn leaf jar of your very own.

You will need:

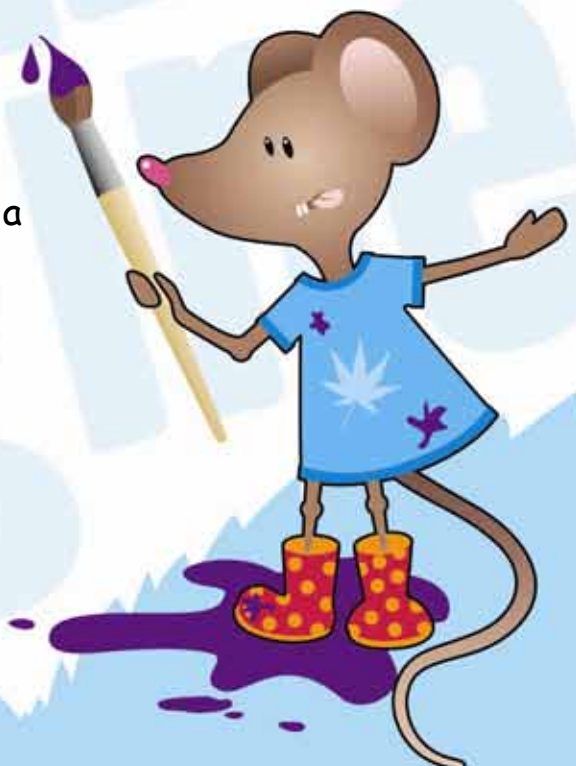
Colourful autumn leaves (not too dry)
An old jam jar
Tissue paper
PVA glue and glue spreader
Water
Kitchen roll



How to make:

- Flatten your leaves by placing them between layers of kitchen roll and placing something heavy on top. Leave for a few hours.
- Use the PVA glue to stick the leaves on to the jar
- Tear up some tissue paper into small pieces and use a mix of PVA glue and water (half & half) to stick it onto the jar on top of the leaves.
- Coat with a final layer of PVA glue and water

When it is dry your leaf jar could be used as a pencil pot, a candle holder or to store your prized conker collection!
