### Horse timber extraction

A chance to witness a delightful scene from the history of the forest as horse power moves logs with ease.

### Apple & pear identification

Experts will be on hand on Saturday and Sunday afternoons to help you to identify your fruit tree (bring three fruits from each tree). Then you can make a permanent label to take home.

### Juice pressing

Bring your own fruit and have it made into delicious juice. No additives here!

### Charcoal burn

See how the Wyre Forest's oak helped to fuel the industries of the past. The charcoal clamp will be opened up on Sunday afternoon.

### Local food market

A chance to taste and buy some of our local produce including fruit, honey, plants and juice.

### Greenwood crafts

Have a go at turning green wood on a pole lathe and watch oak fence posts being made the traditional way.

### Children's activities

Free craft activities led by Wyre Forest Discovery Centre staff.

### Seed gathering

Search for the seeds that will create the landscape of the future. They will be identified and planted in recycled paper pots to nurture at home or sent to be grown on in the Forestry Commission's nursery. If you have grown trees from the seeds you collected last year you can bring them for us to grow on.

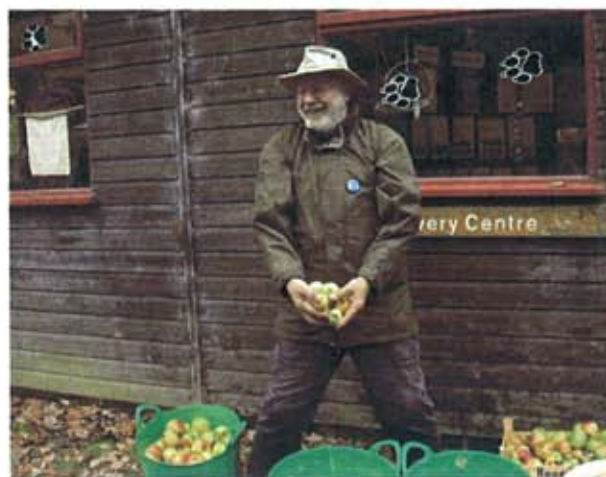
### Chainsaw carving
